FOREWORD

The Institute has decided to focus on the ambitious topic of 'Sexuality' during the forthcoming Conference. For many, it still remains a question waiting to be answered as to why Freud insisted until the end on considering a person's 'Sexuality' as the beginning and end of his/her mental health along with Sublimation which may, due to its great importance, become the focus of the next Conference.

Undoubtedly, when Psychoanalysis refers to 'Sexuality' it cannot simply be referring to 'Sex' or to the biological aspect of this function, but to something much greater that includes both the aforementioned as well as many other aspects in a unique and extremely revealing manner in relation to the functioning of the mental apparatus.

According to Freud the surplus of the narcissistic libido initially cathects the subject's body. It then proceeds with the cathexis of words, ideas and fantasies. Since, however, the overproduction continues, its course outside of the subject and consequently the cathexis of the object becomes inevitable.

Therefore, pursuant to the outcome of a positive Oedipus Complex we reach the object's heterosexual cathexis. This mutual cathexis between man and woman introduces the concept of sexual activity as a necessity accompanied by affective components leading to relief that occurs primarily through the genitals but involves the whole of the psyche.

Psychoanalysis of Neuroses indicates that the Symptoms suggest a fulfilment of sexual desires, carried out unnoticeably because they are due to compromises because of appropriate defences on each occasion centred around the dynamic operation of Repression.

With regard to Perversions, Freud often compares them to Neuroses, using as his argument the absence of a Repression mechanism and the intervention of pre-psychotic mechanisms, such as the splitting of the Ego and the Disavowal from reality. Therefore, Perversion is deduced to something like a primitive, non-repressed manifestation of child sexuality.

Even when there is no desire for the outside world but only Psychotic consequences of a hopeless rejection of the world itself, 'Sexuality' yet again offers a temporary solution through Masturbation and its equivalents.

During this Conference we will witness 'Sexuality' spread like a veil, covering everything without even being noticed in most cases.

We hope that you will actively participate in the Conference.
